



Santa Clarita Woodlands Park - Pico Canyon
 27201 Pico Canyon Road, Newhall, California, 91381

Pico Canyon, located in the northern portion of the Santa Clarita Woodlands Park, is home to a rich and active oil history. Explore the remaining historic buildings of Mentryville, an oil boom town. Pico Canyon features large valley and coast live oaks, chaparral-dominated slopes, and views of Santa Clarita.

Directions: From the San Fernando Valley, go north on the 5 Freeway, take the Lyons exit and turn left at the stop sign at off-ramp. Cross over the freeway (west) and continue straight on Pico Canyon road. Bear left at the Y intersection, and continue to end of road.
