

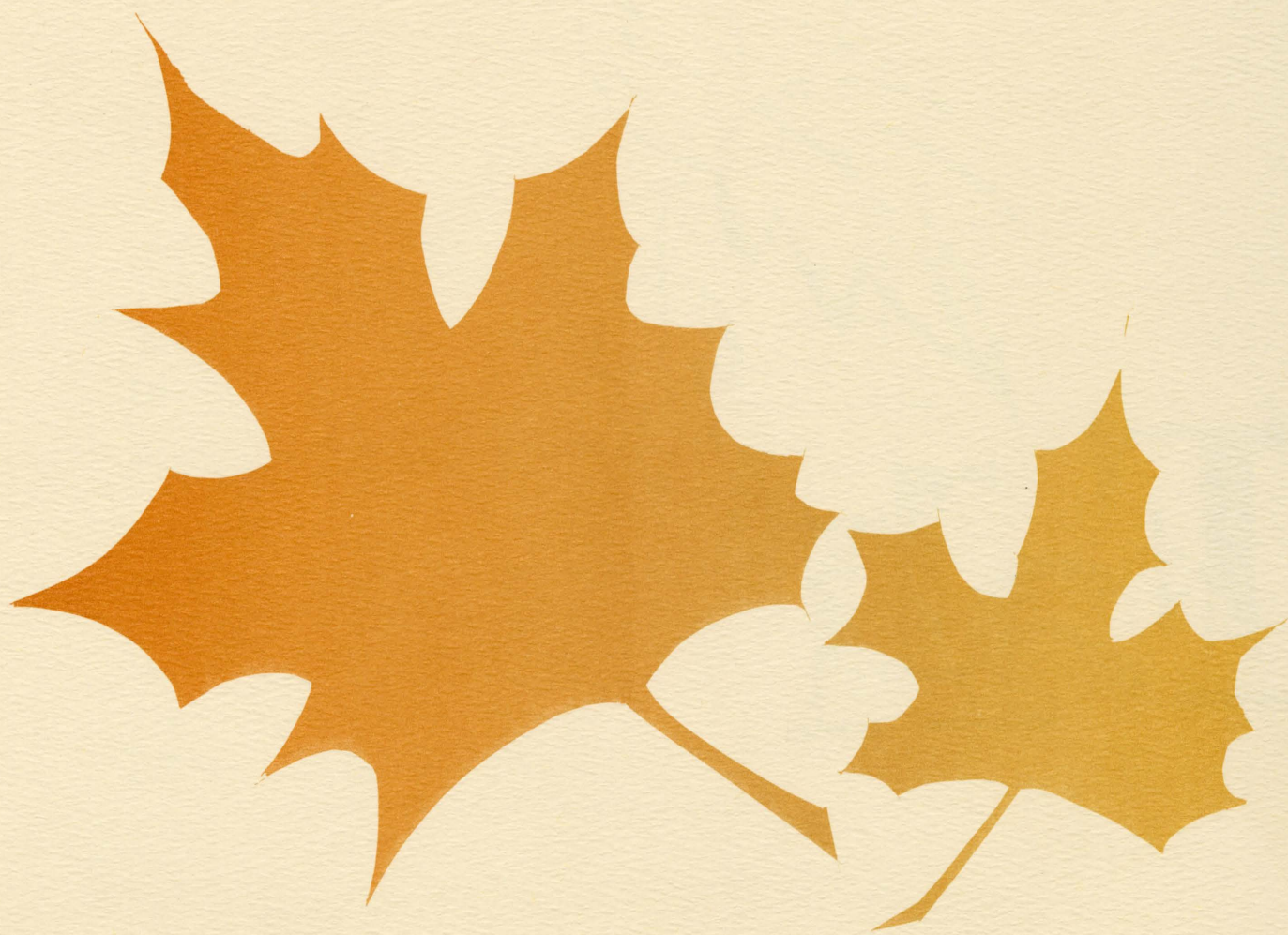

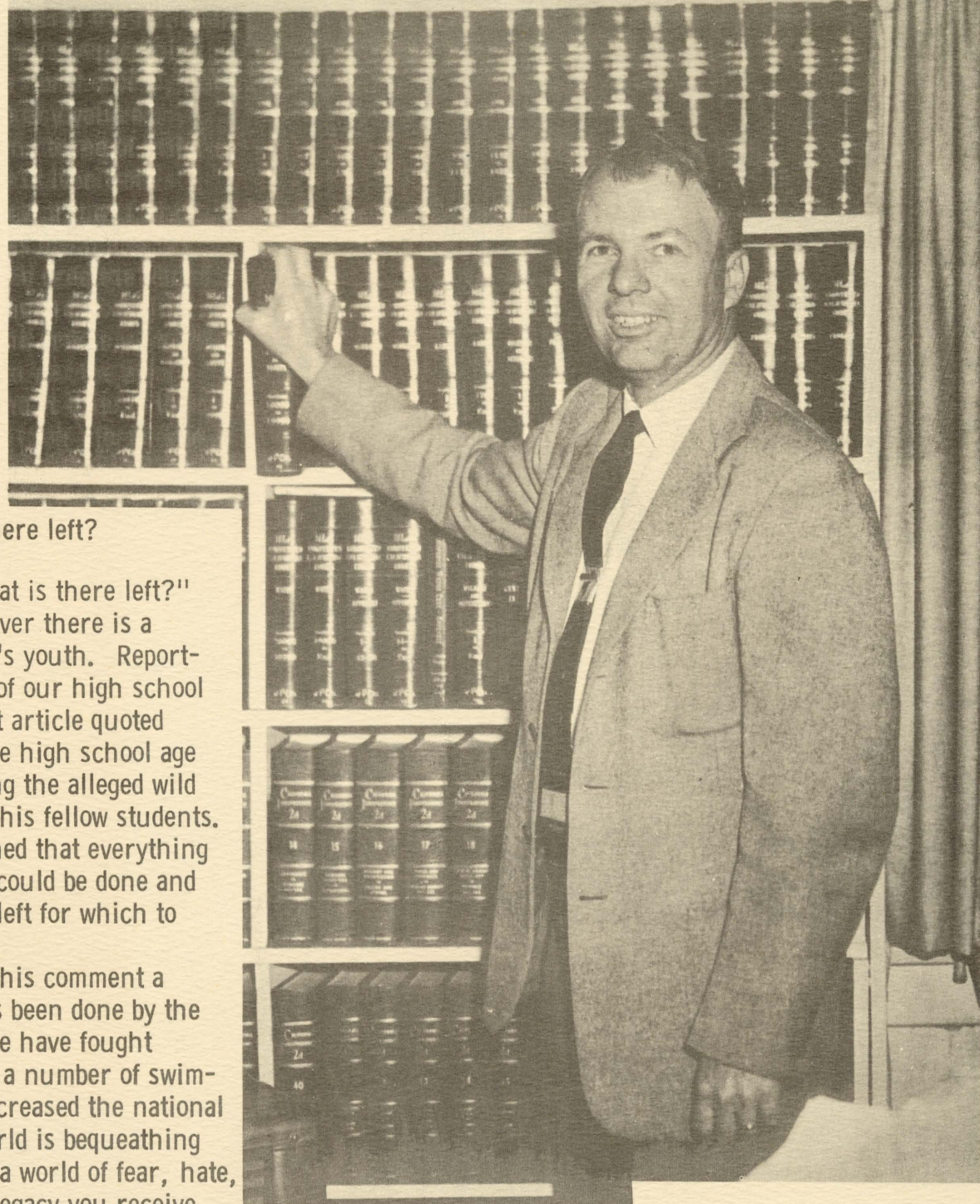
What is there left?

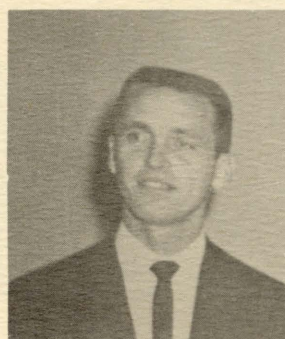


Last season certainly was not successful as far as the score board was concerned; however, I feel that the boys will profit by their mistakes.

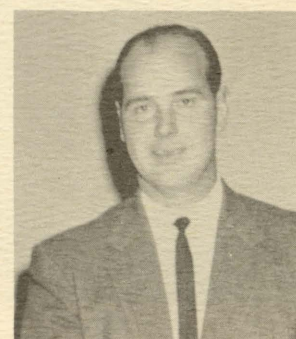
We lost several of our linemen and most of our backfield at graduation. We are counting on junior varsity talent which, we have noticed, includes several good prospects.
