On behalf of the Hart Quarterback Club, I would like to welcome you to tonight's game and thank you for your support.

1999 brought the Hart Football Program a season like no other. The Indians won their 9th consecutive Foothill League Championship, finished undefeated at 14-0 and culminated the year with a 34-6 win over the Valencia Vikings as Hart became CIF Division III Champions for the second consecutive year. "Back to Back" Southern Section Champs for the first time in school history.

The Quarterback Club is responsible for most of the financial support of all three levels of the Hart Football Program: freshman, junior varsity and varsity. 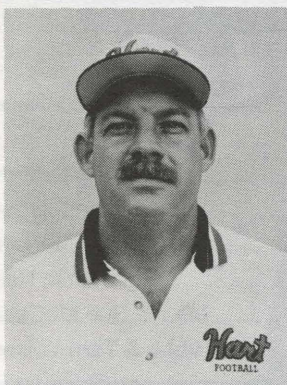

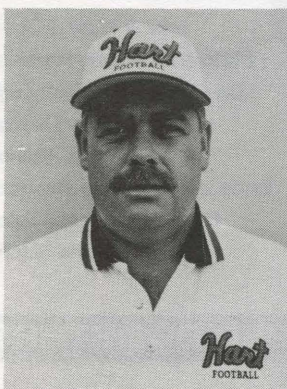

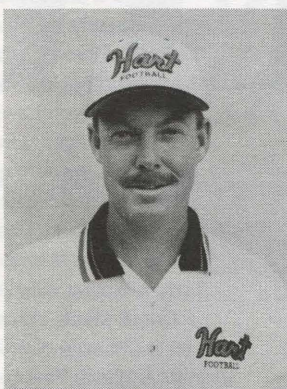
Mike Herrington - Head Coach

Coach Mike Herrington begins his twelfth year as Head Football Coach at Hart High School. In eleven seasons under Herrington, the Indians have compiled ten Foothill League Championships (1989, 1991-99), three CIF Championships (1995, 1998 & 1999), and were CIF runners-up in 1994. Coach Herrington's career record is 128-26, which includes a one-year stint as head coach at Bellflower High School in 1988. Coach Herrington began his coaching career at Hart High School in 1980 and was an assistant coach until 1987. During those eight seasons, he was involved in five league championships and two CIF Championships (1983, 1986). Coach Herrington has resided in Newhall most of his life and is an alumnus of Hart High. He attended and played offensive line for two seasons at College of the Canyons and two seasons at CSUN. Coach Herrington teaches Physical Education and Health at Hart and is also the Athletic Director.



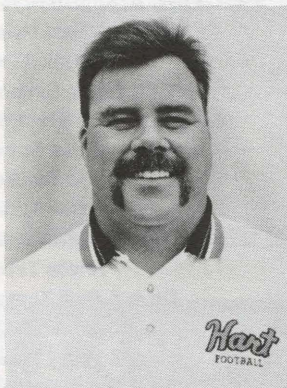
Rick Herrington - Defensive Coordinator

Coach Rick Herrington enters his twelfth year as Hart's Defensive Coordinator. In his 22 years of coaching, Rick has had success on every level he has coached, including four consecutive undefeated seasons (40-0) in the mid 80's. In the past 10 years, Rick has developed eighteen all-league linebackers and an All-CIF linebacker in each of the last six seasons. A Hart graduate, Rick attended College of the Canyons and graduated from CSUN. He teaches Special Education at Hart, where he also coaches golf. Dean Herrington - Offensive Coordinator

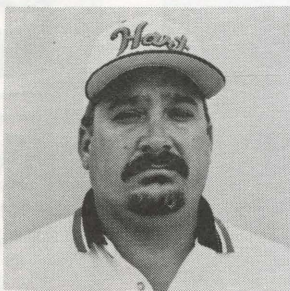

Dan Houghton - Assistant Coach

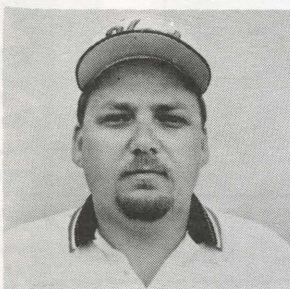

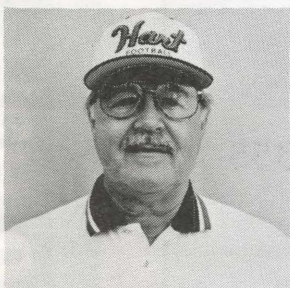
Mike Halcovich - Assistant Coach

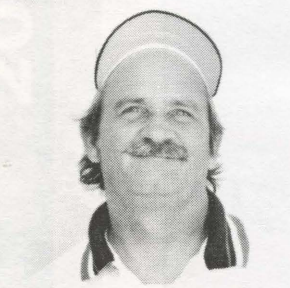
John Ahart - Assistant Coach

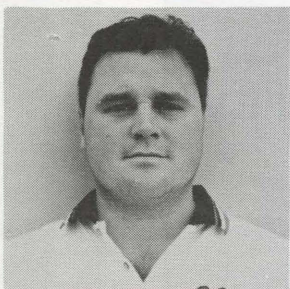
Dave Lind - Athletic Trainer

The Indians are coming off a season opening victory against the Monroe Vikings, 36-6. The Lancers lost a close game to Crescenta Valley, 24-20.

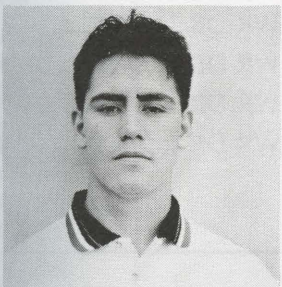
Chris Thurm - Defensive Coordinator

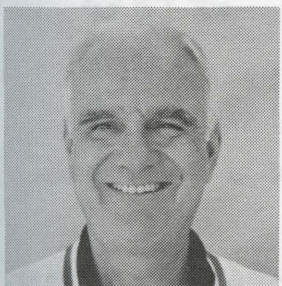
Chris Irons - Assistant Coach

Dan Cota - Head Coach



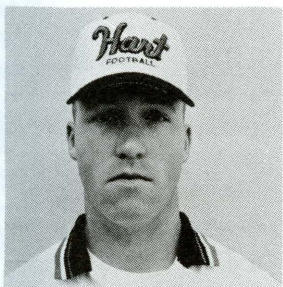

Don Cruikshank - Assistant Coach



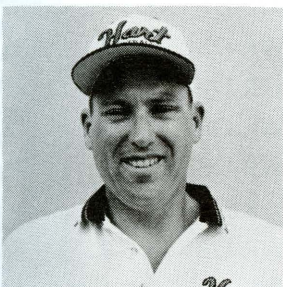

Bryan Martuscello - Assistant Coach



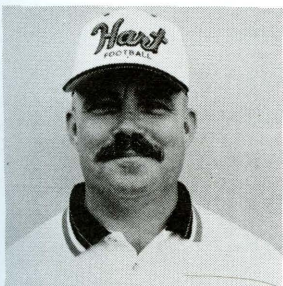
