
Dear Graduates:


Dear Graduate:

I plan to take a class at College of the Canyons, like a motion picture class. Then, I'd like to become a stunt man.

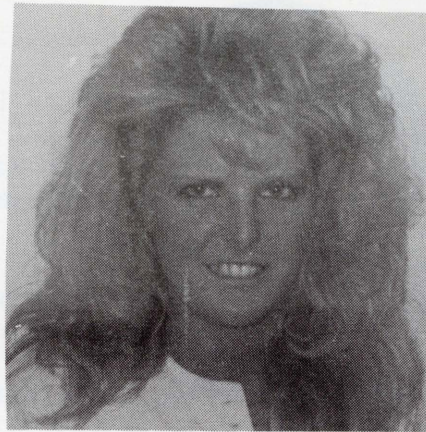

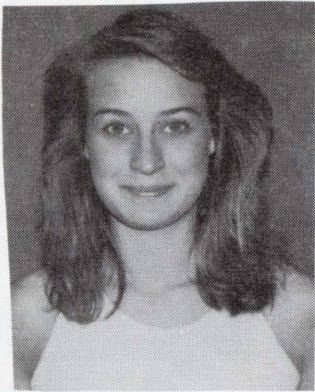

First, I plan to attend a junior college and obtain a fulltime job. Then I plan to go to New York to study interior design.



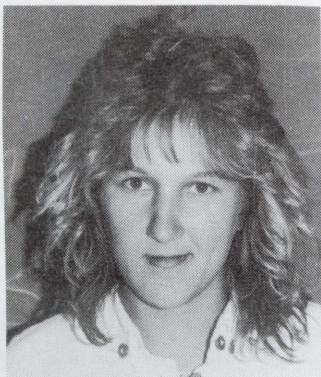

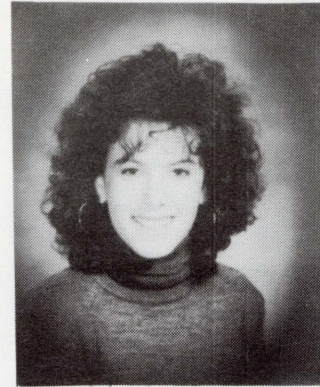

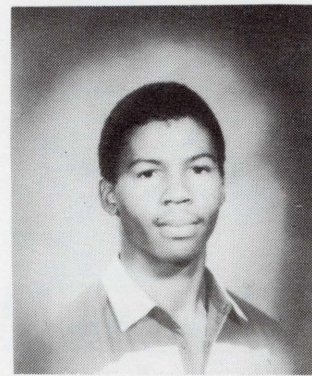

After I graduate I plan to go to college. My main goal in life is to be a high fashion model.



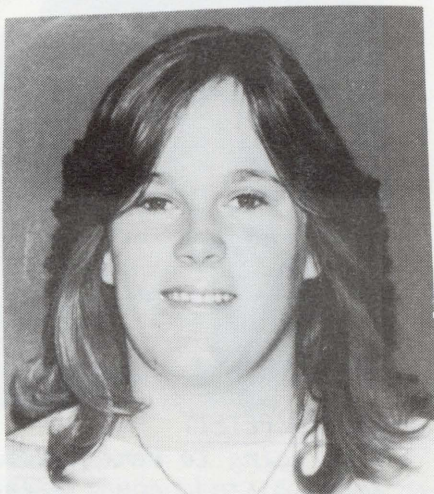
