

T plan to go to College of the Canyons for two years and then transfer to a university.



JASON LEVY - I will all my spare change and extra money to Harlan for my grades; and my stereo system to Mike Ehrhart.


MICHELLE MATHEWS - I will to Harlan many difficult students like me!
