- PHILANA PAGE - All the great friendships I made at the Learning Post.

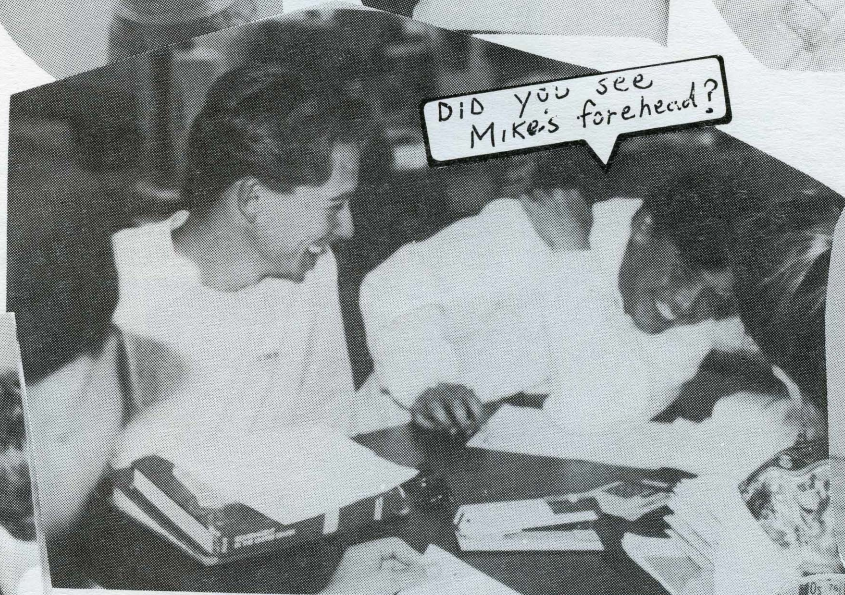

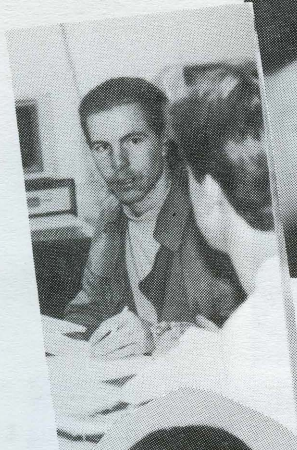
- EILEEN ORANTES - I enjoyed being in Karen's class because it is fun and interesting. I learned a lot from this class and I thank Karen.
