GINA WALLERSTEIN Walking in the door at school and seeing Holly with a smile on her face.

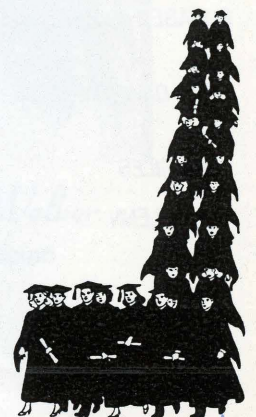
