This is in response to your request for a determination letter of the above-named organization.

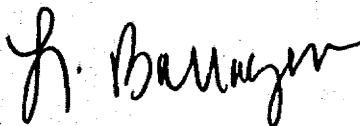

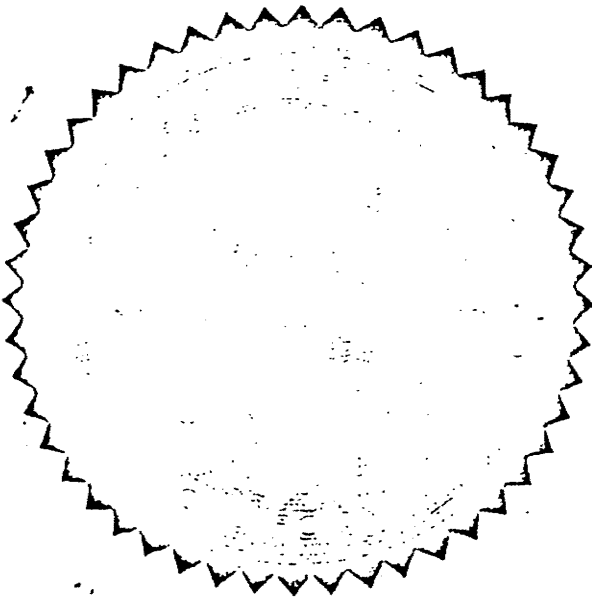

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SANTA CLARITA VALLEY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

I

The name of this corporation shall be SANTA CLARITA VALLEY HISTORICAL SOCIETY.

II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(a) The specific and primary purposes are for the collection, preservation, and publication of any and all papers, books, documents, photos, prints, records, etc., that have any historical significance to Santa Clarita Valley and surrounding areas.

(b) Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation.

(c) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Non-profit Corporation Law of the State of California.

VII

This corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and it is organized solely for nonprofit purposes. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational,

literary, and/or scientific purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If this corporation holds any assets on trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree of the superior court of the county in which this corporation's principal office is located, upon petition therefor by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.
