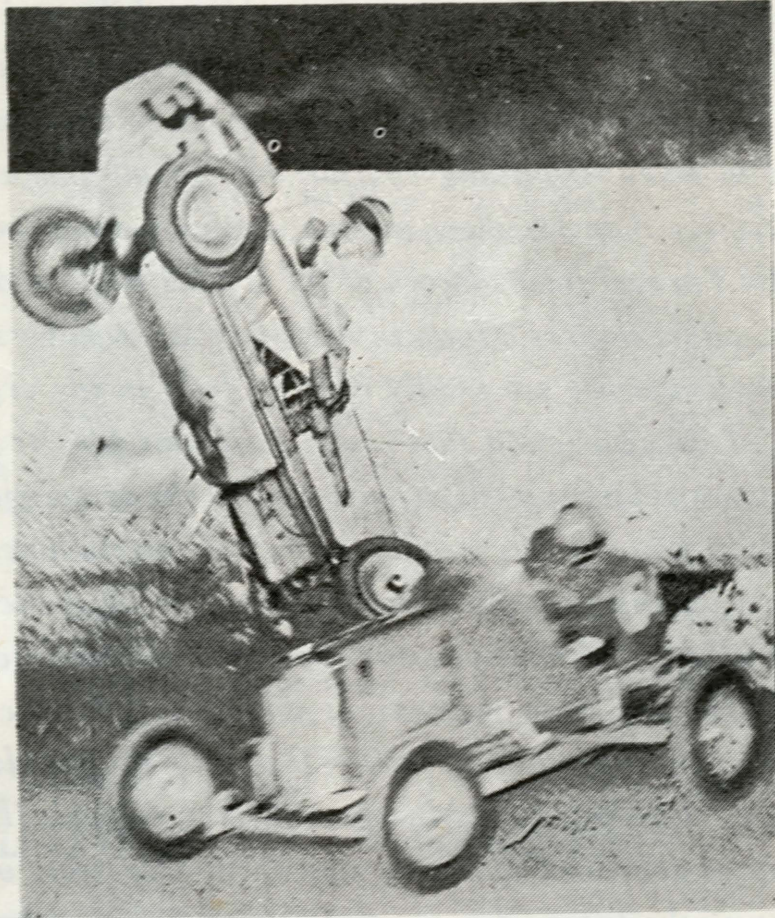

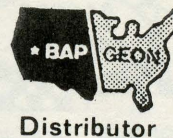
OLIMPIC RACING ASSN.

FLAG RULES

GREEN FLAG	Displayed at the start of practice, qualifying or a race. The track is under full racing conditions until any other flag is shown.
RED/YELLOW	Complete restart.
YELLOW FLAG	Caution, go slow, single file, hold your position, no passing.
RED FLAG	Danger, stop immediately at first safe opportunity. Track totally unsafe for racing.
BLACK FLAG	Tells a driver he has something wrong....either with his car or his driving technique....that could endanger the safety of other drivers on the track. In either case, the flag means slow immediately for consultation with pit crew or race officials.
WHITE FLAG	Signifies one lap remaining in either race or qualifying.
CHECKERED	End of race or final qualifying lap.
BLUE/YELLOW	Informs drivers they are being lapped by faster cars. It is mandatory and must be obeyed.

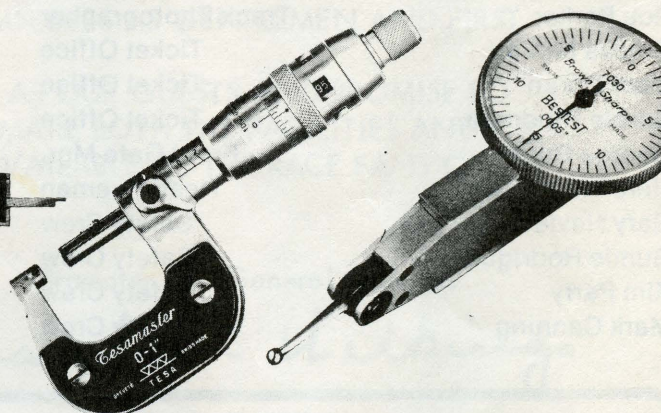

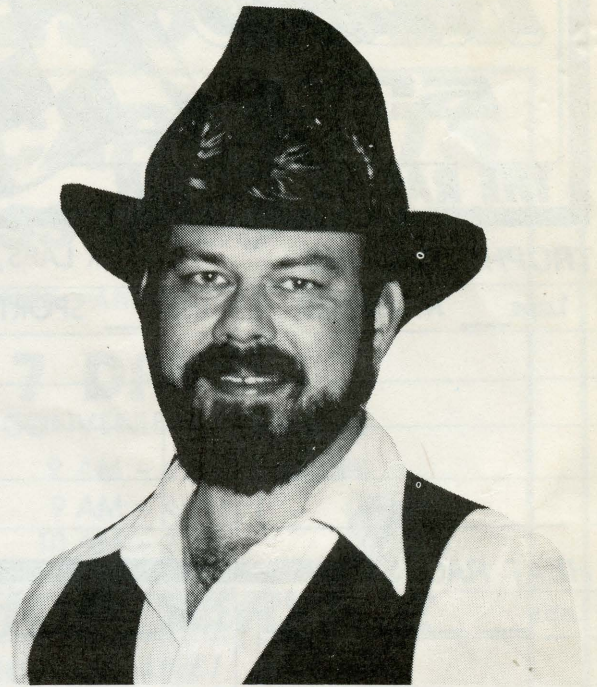
Meet Virg Kilpatrick

1979 REVIEW

Tru Cheek, John Covan and Roman Calczynski drove to divisional championships at Saugus Speedway in 1979. Cheek captured the crown in the newly formed Modified division, Covan won the Sportsman cup and Calczynski topped the Street Stocks. The championships were the first ever for each of these fine competitors.

Cheek, after scoring an opening night victory, lead the points chase all the way and capped it off by winning the regular season-ending 100-lap Modified Grand Prix. Along the way he posted two other feature wins, four seconds and five thirds as he successfully fought off a late-season charge by '77 Champion Jim Robinson who recorded five feature victories at the "Super Track". Robinson also holds the current qualifying record of 16:36 which he set on September 29th. Jim Inoslo, '68 champ, clocked 16:46 on opening night and Dan Press, 1978 title-holder lowered it to 16:44 on May 19th, prior to Robinson's current record run.

Covan battled with Allen Thacker throughout most of the season in the Sportsman division but Covan's consistent top three finishes won him the crown and Gary Johnson nosed past Thacker by winning the final Sportsman event, the 100-lap Grand Prix.

Calczynski racked up fourteen victories in feature races and scored ten dash wins to slip past Thacker on the final night of Street Stock action. Jon Christensen, Cindy Davar, Bruce Erickson, Ken Johnston, Chris Peedan, Greg Scates and Jim Smelzer also drove to feature wins in the very competitive division. Brad Miller won the Bill Killian Memorial Race, an event to honor the memory of the four-time Saugus Champion that lost his life in a highway truck accident in November of 1978.

SUPER TRACK SCENE

Hello race fans and welcome to 1980, the beginning of a new decade and the start of another exciting race season at Saugus Speedway. This will mark the sixth decade that auto racing history has been recorded here at Saugus, the oldest auto racing facility in the Western United States.

The following is a brief chronological history of Saugus Speedway:

- 1924 Roy Baker, brother of shoe magnate C. H. Baker builds "Baker Ranch Stadium" a completely enclosed rodeo arena seating over 12,000 fans.
- 1930 Baker, caught up in the great depression, sold the stadium to cowboy actor "Hoot" Gibson. Gibson drew the Hollywood crowd to the stadium and used it as a movie set, or leased it to other companies making films. Rodeos were the main attraction with such western stars as Harry Carey, Tom Mix, William S. Hart and John Wayne looking on.
- 1934 Gibson sold the ranch to Paul Hill, operator of the Western Livestock Stockyards.
- 1937 Year of the big flood! Water rushing down Soledad Canyon filled the stadium and ranch house with debris. The clean up effort was just too much for Hill, and so the bank took the property back.
- 1937-38 Purchased by William Bonelli and renamed Bonelli Stadium.
- 1939 "Big Bill" Bonelli started auto racing. Its flat dirt oval was tested by the top drivers of the late 30's and early 40's. Sunday afternoon crowds of ten to twelve thousand watched as "open wheel" greats such as Troy Ruttman, Bill Vukovich sr., Allen Heath, Walt Faulkner, Johnny McDowell, Jack McGrath, Mel Hanson, Danny Oaks and many other fine drivers dueled in the dirt. Many of these fine drivers sat on the "bricks" at Indianapolis each Memorial Day.
- 1940-41 Was regular stop on United Racing Association circuit. Johnny Parsons was the champion in both years.
- 1942 June 30th last race due to war. Track lay idle during '43 and '44.
- 1945 Sunday, September 9, 1945, first post-war race on west coast. That first race in '45 found the late Billy Vukovich grabbing the first checkered flag to be waved in post-war auto racing. Nine race meetings were held during the year and the championship was won by Vukovich.
- 1946 Dirt track paved for first time but pavement was later torn out and track was reverted to dirt.
- 1947 Midget racing, the new sensation across the country, continued to draw large crowds through 1946, but in '47 the big roadsters roared onto the scene. They were the chief attraction until 1950 when the midgets made a comeback.
- 1950 The years had taken its toll on the original stands and it was in this year that the backstretch stands were replaced by "importing" stands from the famous Gilmore Stadium when it closed down in 1950.
- 1951-55 The midgets and roadsters shared the track about equally with occasional rodeos and circuses.
- 1956 Track paved for second time, this pavement was destined to last many years longer than that of 1946.
- 1957 First "stock car" racing event.....

That first stock car race was promoted by Tony Coldewey who later formed the Pacific Racing Association. Only 23 cars were on hand for that first race and the spectators numbered less than 400. Many said it would'nt last, and here it is 1980, already! In future issues of the program we will continue the very interesting history of the "Super Track".

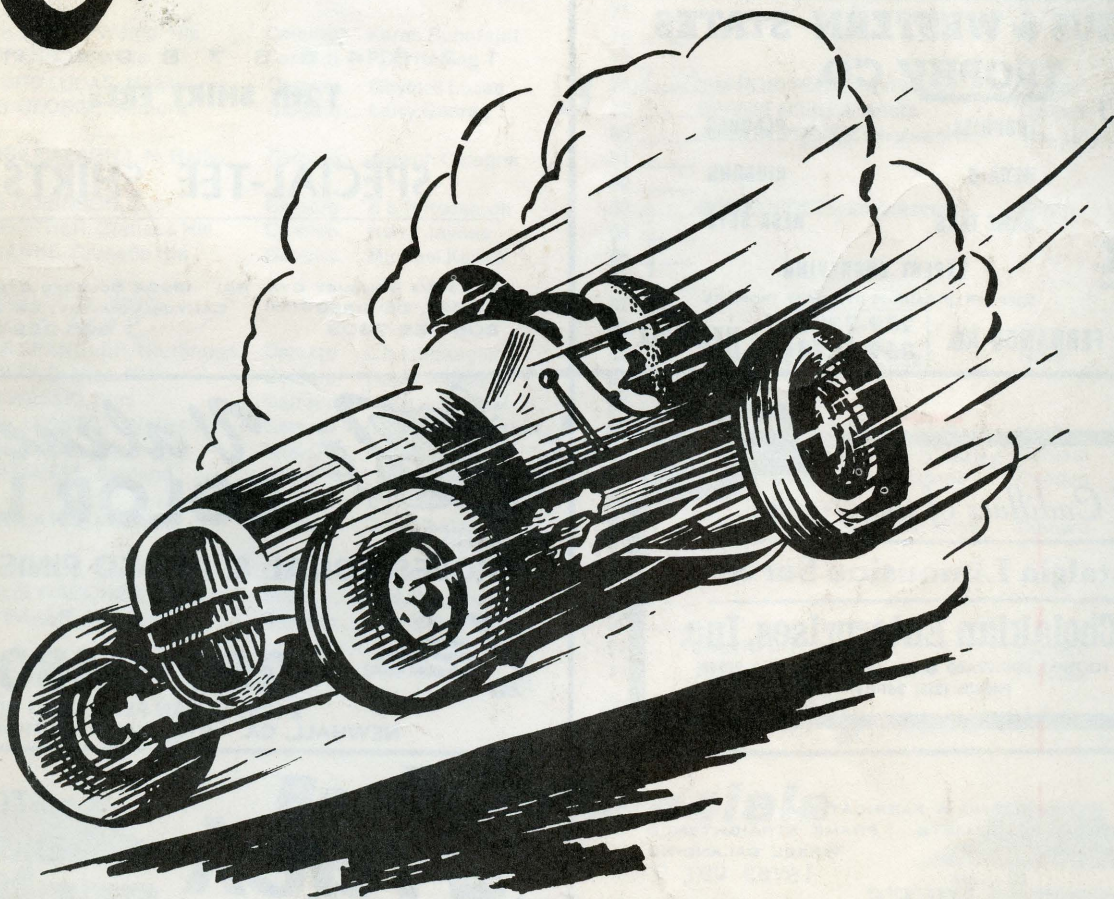

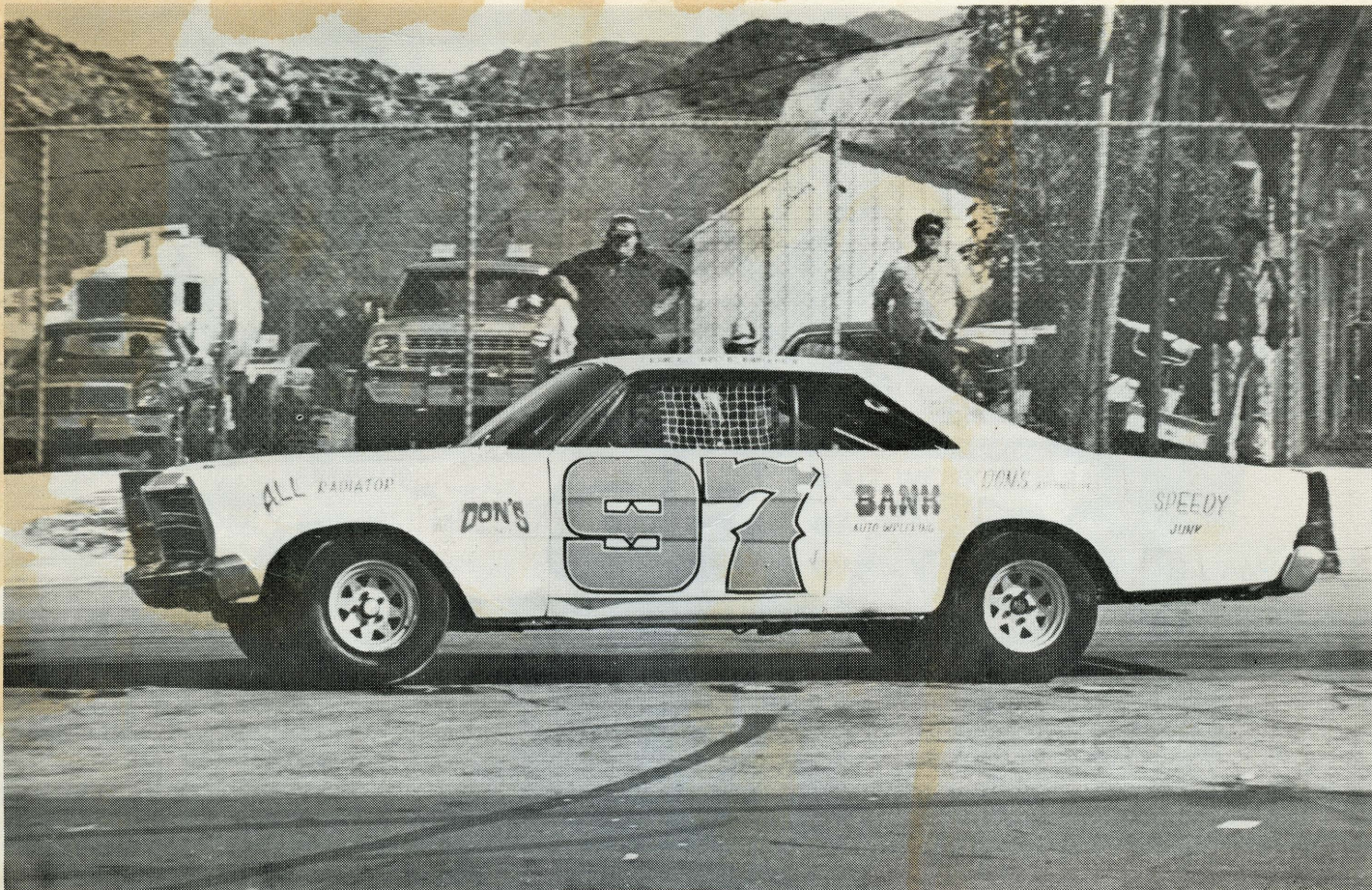

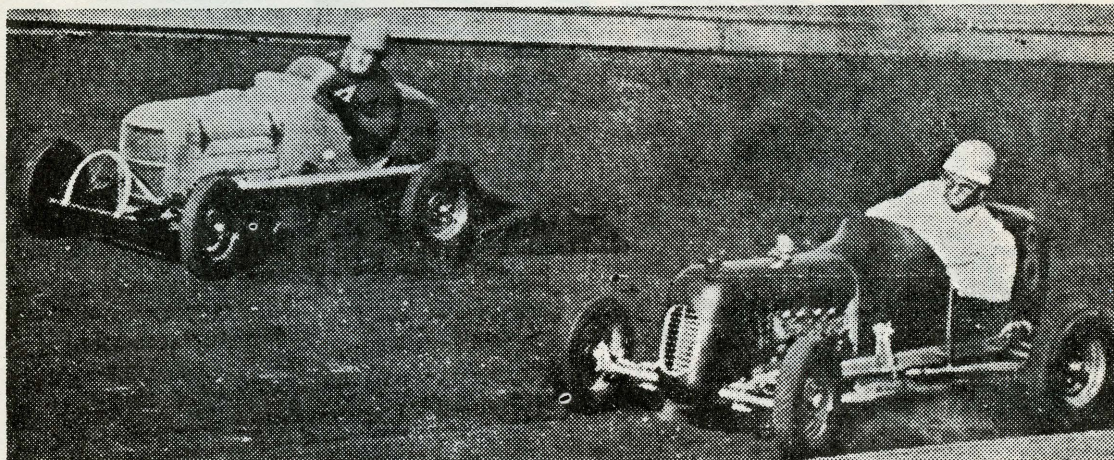

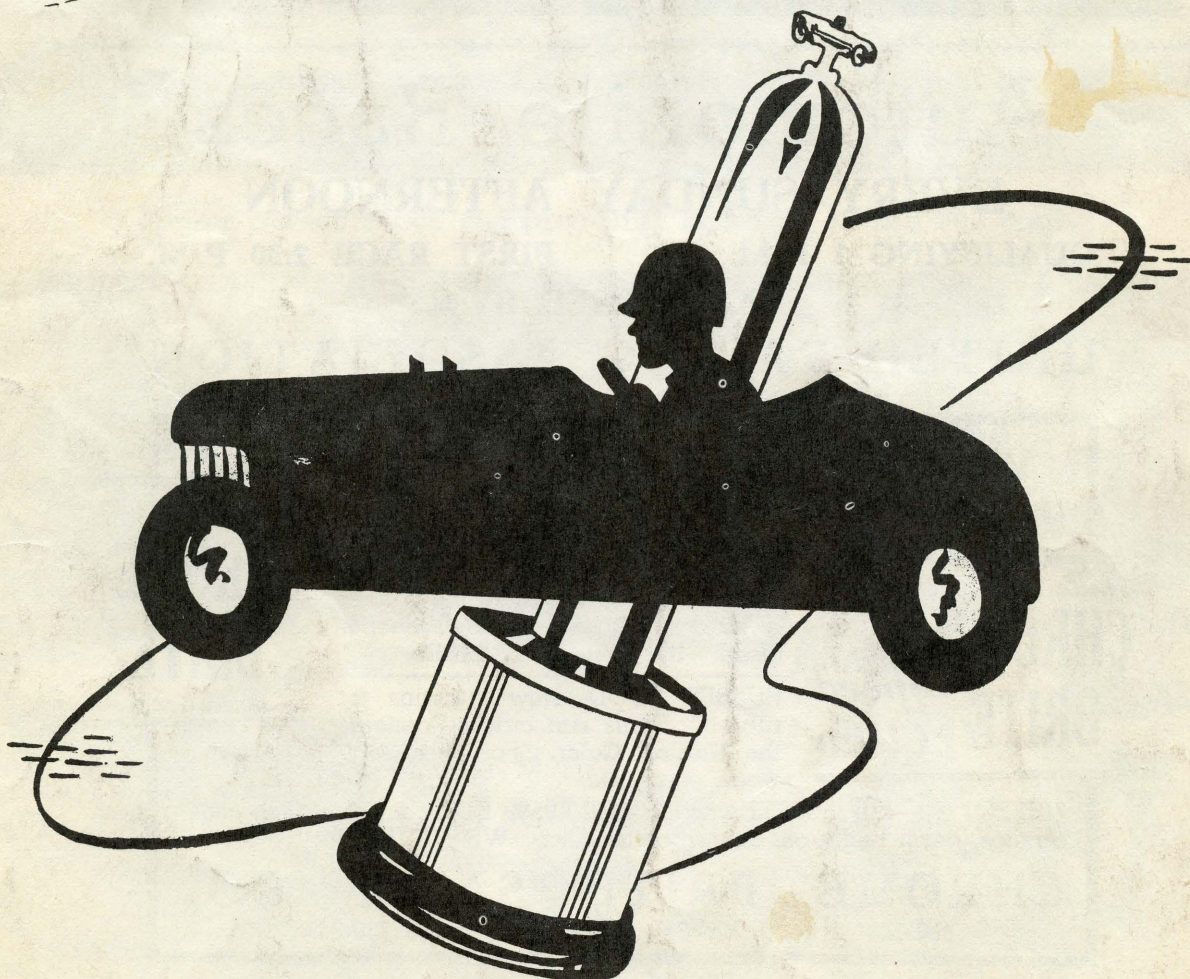
