## *Descendants of James Mitchell, Sr.*

### *Generation No. 1*

1. JAMES<sup>1</sup> MITCHELL, SR. was born Abt. 1720 in Ireland, and died in Kentucky?. He married MARGARET CALDWELL, daughter of JOHN CALDWELL and MARGARET PHILLIPS. She was born 1712 in Ireland, and died 1791 in Kentucky.

Notes for JAMES MITCHELL, SR.:

As you can see from below we have not developed adequate factual information to accept James Mitchell Sr. as the father of James Mitchell Jr.. We have included James Sr. in the hope that our information can be further confirmed by factual information discovered by other Mitchell family genealogists.

Much of what we know about James Mitchell Jr. comes from a sworn statement he made in Robertson County, Tennessee to support his claim for his Revolutionary War pension. That document tells us that he was born in Bedford County, Virginia 17 November 1754. It continues, relating his service in the Virginia Militia and the Continental Army. He stated " In the fall of 1776 he lived in the house of John Rodgers in the county of Bedford and the State of Virginia that he volunteered in a rifle company under Capt. Christofer Irvine." He mentions where he lived after he left the service. He went to Mercer County, Kentucky in the fall of 1781 and to Tennessee in 1807. [From James Mitchell's files in the National Archives. Copy in Section I.]

Family genealogists working on the Mitchell and allied families have come up with several scenarios concerning James Mitchell Jr.'s possible parents. Caldwell genealogists have documented a particular Caldwell family, tracing the line from Scotland to Northern Ireland, to Delaware, through Pennsylvania, Virginia and on to Kentucky. The writer believes the information on the Mitchell connection with the line gets a bit sparse when it gets to Virginia. However, several things mentioned by James Mitchell Jr. and the writer's father seem to tie in to this scenario.

This is the possible Caldwell-Mitchell tie-in. A John Caldwell married a Margaret Phillips in Ireland. They had five children before coming to America. They arrived in Delaware in 1727 moving to Pennsylvania and then into Virginia near the Roanoke River. John Caldwell's only daughter, Margaret, married a William Rodgers and by him had five children. He died in 1750. Margaret married as her second husband a man named James Mitchell abt 1752. They had five children.

Margaret's brother, William Caldwell, had a daughter Martha who married a Patrick Calhoun in South Carolina. They had a son, John Caldwell Calhoun, who was very prominent in the US Federal Government for many years. He served as Vice President for John Quincy Adams and Andrew Jackson. He served as Secretary of War and State as well as serving in the US Senate.

The source of much of the information connecting these families comes from a letter written by John Rodgers, son of William Rodgers and Margaret Caldwell to a Caldwell cousin, Elias Caldwell, in the early 1800s. [Virginia Magazine of History and Biography, Vol. 19, p. 92]

What ties this information to James Mitchell Jr.? If the James Mitchell that married Margaret Caldwell is James Mitchell Jr.'s father, then James Mitchell Jr. and John Rodgers, the writer of the letter were half-brothers. We note in James' sworn statement that he was living in the house of John Rodgers in 1776. On October 4, 1780 John Rodgers, Mary C. Rogers and Ann Rogers witnessed a will for John Willson. Security was furnished by James Mitchell, John Rodgers and Samuel Clayton. [Bedford County, Virginia Will Book 1, p. 382 ] In 1781 both James Mitchell and John Rodgers moved to Kentucky. [John Rodgers' letter and James Mitchell's sworn statement.] John Rodgers writes in his letter that his mother's son, Robert, died in Kentucky. Court records of Mercer County, Kentucky show that ["That the administration on the estate of Robert Mitchell, decd, is granted to Daniel Mitchell and George Shipley, who entered into a bond of 1000 pounds with George Caldwell, James Mitchell and Adam Mitchell as sureties. Robert Caldwell, Abraham Irvine, John Cook and James Brumfield or any three of them, to make appraisal of the personal property of the decedent." [ Mercer County, Kentucky Court Records, p. 308.] This document involved four Mitchells, two Caldwells, one Irvine and one Brumfield. James Mitchell's dau., Betsy, married Caleb Irvine and James Mitchell's wife was Betsy Brumfield who had a brother James. [ From Robert Brumfield's will executed in Mercer Co., Kentucky 27 February 1790 which mentions both his s. James and dau. Betsy Mitchell. Will Book 1, pps. 183, 184, 185.]

Going back to Margaret Caldwell's niece Martha, mother of John C. Calhoun. James Mitchell Jr. and John Rodgers would be John C. Calhoun's first cousins once removed. The writer asked his father on several

occasions if we Mitchells were related to any famous people. He always stated that Daniel Boone and John C. Calhoun were cousins and that we were related in some way to Zachary Taylor. The writer believes that Tom Mitchell must have passed this information on to his family. Further Tom Mitchell was twenty-five years old when John C. Calhoun died and should have known who his living cousins were. John Rodgers in his letter to his cousin, Elias Caldwell, mentions their relative, John C. Calhoun.

The above is not enough information to accept the James Mitchell in the Caldwell scenario as our James Mitchell's father but it certainly stimulates further detailed research to locate more pieces of the puzzle.

Notes for MARGARET CALDWELL:

Margaret Caldwell Rodgers married James Mitchell Sr. as her second husband.

Her first husband was William Rodgers.

2. JAMES<sup>2</sup> MITCHELL, JR. (*JAMES<sup>1</sup>*) was born 17 November 1754 in Bedford County, Virginia, and died 18 May 1835 in Robertson County, Tennessee. He married BETSY (ELIZABETH MITCHELL) BRUMFIELD 6 January 1787 in Mercer County, Kentucky, daughter of ROBERT BRUMFIELD. She was born 11 September 1763 in Virginia, and died 11 September 1828 in Robertson County, Tennessee.

Notes for JAMES MITCHELL, JR.:

Information for James Mitchell is from his military records from the National Archives, his will, found in Will Book 9, p. 87, Robertson County, Tennessee. Tennessee Daughters of the American Revolution Cemetery Book, Robertson County, Mitchell Cemetery p. 252, Marriage Records, Mercer County, Kentucky, Robertson County's Heritage of Homes.

3. JOHN C.<sup>3</sup> MITCHELL (*JAMES<sup>2</sup>, JAMES<sup>1</sup>*) was born Abt. 1795 in Mercer County, Kentucky, and died 18 September 1868 in Tanglewood, Lee County, Texas. He married MARTHA W. CARTER 1819 in Halifax County, North Carolina?, daughter of WILSON CARTER and MARY UNKNOWN. She was born Abt. 1800 in Halifax, North Carolina, and died Abt. 1830 in Tennessee.

Notes for JOHN C. MITCHELL:

[John C. Mitchell's year of birth is based on 1860 US Census for Burleson County, Texas, p. 16, line 39, dwelling 103 and cemetery records of Lee County, Texas which gave his age as 73.] He was the oldest son of James Mitchell and Betsey Brumfield. [James Mitchell's will, Robertson County, Tennessee, Will Book 9, pps. 87 and 88.] Little is known of his early life. It is possible that he served in the War of 1812. During that time in Tennessee there was only one John C. Mitchell to be found in public records. A John C. Mitchell served as a private in Captain John Wallace's Company in Hall's 1 Regiment, Tennessee Volunteers. [File No. 842, 1 Regiment (Hall's), Tennessee Volunteer's, card numbers 384776583, 6664, 6733, 6802. From The National Archives.]

On 14 September 1820, John C. Mitchell and his wife, Martha W. Mitchell, of Robertson County, Tennessee appeared in court in Halifax County, North Carolina to collect Martha's share of her late father, Wilson W. Carter's estate. [Halifax County, North Carolina Deed Book 25, p. 269. ] While in Halifax County their first son, James Wilson Mitchell, was born. [ Birth based on city directories of Cleburne, Texas, US Census and family tradition.]

On 14 September 1820 John and Martha bought from Lewis H. B. Whitaker six hundred and sixty acres along Caleb's Creek in Robertson County Tennessee. This land was less than ten miles from James Mitchell's farm on the Elk Fork. [ Halifax County, North Carolina Deed Book 25.] Lewis H.B. Whitaker was a distant cousin of Martha's. John and Martha remained in Robertson County until sometime in the early 1830s when they moved to Fayette County, Tennessee near Martha's brother, Borrows Carter's, holdings. [1833 entry in Fayette County, Tennessee Deed Book D, describes John Mitchell's land as lying in Range 6, Section 4, a part of Samuel Polk's 1245 acre land entry.] Mitchell's property was about nine miles north of Somerville, Fayette County seat.

Martha died while her children were quite young and her grave's site has not been located. It is possible that she was buried in the Carter Cemetery but there is no entry in the Carter family bible nor in cemetery records. John C. Mitchell remarried Anna C. Mc Cardle, a widow, from New York City on 18 December 1843. [Memphis Daily Eagle, 2 February 1844 Edition.]

In the spring of 1847 John and Anna moved to Washington County, Texas. [ Date from the diary of Mary Elizabeth Mitchell Elgin.] Before 1850 they moved to Burleson County where they were enumerated in the 1850 U.S. Census. [ 1850 US Census, Burleson County, Texas, roll 908, dwelling 35.] On 29 January 1855 John C. Mitchell purchased over one thousand acres from John Burton. [Burleson County, Texas, Deed Book D, pps. 492 and 493.]

John and Anna had one son, Francis L. Mitchell who was enumerated in the 1860 census. They were still living in Burleson County near Lexington. They must have been doing well as John lists his assets as being over \$16,000.

John C. Mitchell died on 18 September 1868 at the age of seventy three. He is buried in the Hugh Wilson Cemetery at Tanglewood in Lee County. Tanglewood is a small community about five miles north of Lexington. His obituary reads: "John C. Mitchell departed this life Sept. 18, 1868 in the 73rd year of his age in hopes of a glorious immortality". [Information from the Cemetery Books in the Lee County Courthouse and tombstone photo courtesy of William Frank Bumpas, a relative of Dr. John E. Elgin who was Mary Elizabeth Mitchell's husband.]

In the 1870 census we find Anna C. Mitchell and a spinster daughter Caroline. Her youngest daughter, Sarah, has married a John M. Porter and Anna seems to be living with the Porters. In the 1880 census, Anna and the Porters are found living in Bell County. Anna and Caroline are still living with them. John Porter is no longer a farmer but a minister of the Gospel

Notes for ROBERT MITCHELL:

We have very little information concerning Robert Mitchell. Tom Mitchell told his children that he and his brother, Robert, became separated on their way from Tennessee to Texas and that he never saw his brother again. Tom's sister, Mary Elizabeth Mitchell Elgin, wrote in her diary of receiving a letter from her brother, James, telling of their brother's death. She wrote: " February 1st 1848. I received a letter from James which makes me feel melancholy. It brings unwelcome tidings of a brother's death. He died in a foreign land with no dear friend or sister to smooth his dying pillow if he were so fortunate to have one. My poor brother we will never meet again in this world. I pray to God we may meet in heaven where fighting will be no more." (It seems probable that Robert was killed in the Mexican War.)

Notes for CALEB IRVINE:

Caleb Irvine served as an officer in the Mexican War. He also served later on the Western Frontier. Some family historian state that Caleb was a graduate of West Point. The United States Military Academy records do not support this .

Notes for SAMUEL FINDLEY MITCHELL:

Samuel Findley Mitchell sold his interests in his father's lands to brother Robert B. Mitchell in 1841 and moved to someplace in Missouri. He returned to Robertson County in 1859 and purchased about one hundred acres from the Robert Shanklin estate where he built a Greek Revival mansion that was one of the show places

of Robertson County until it burned down in 1988.

He married MARIA MOURNING ISBELL 26 January 1858 in Todd County, Kentucky. She was born 12 July 1833 in Todd County, Kentucky, and died 1909 in Cleburne, Texas.

Notes for JAMES WILSON MITCHELL:

James Wilson Mitchell was sent by his family somewhere to college. His descendants believe it was to medical school but he never practiced medicine. In his younger days he was a school teacher. The writer's father said that James had a pharmacy in his bookstore in Cleburne, Texas but is not so listed in Cleburne City directories. However a picture of James' bookstore seemed to have books on one side of the store a what appear to be many apothecary jars on the other along with a soda fountain. James' great grandson, Irvin Jarrell said that James was well versed in Latin and Greek.

James was a veteran of the Mexican War having participated in the ill-fated Somerville Campaign. He was a officer in Texas Forces of the C.S.A. during the Civil War.

Notes for JOHN EDWARD ELGIN, CAPTAIN JACK:

Captain Jack Elgin, with a hard "g" please, was considered a bit of a character by a number of members of his family. He was obviously a man of many talents and great energy and enthusiasm. According to a letter written by his father, Dr. John Elgin, he was named Jack and not John. He used both names. The writer's father, his first cousin, always referred to him as Captain Jack and quite a character.

She was born 24 December 1847 in Little Rock Arkansas, and died 10 August 1905 in

Canyon Country, L A County, CA.

Notes for THOMAS FINDLEY MITCHELL:

Sources: Recollections of Thomas's children, military and pension records from the National Archives, History of Los Angeles County.

Thomas served as a private and sergeant in Shapely P. Ross' Company of Mounted Texas Volunteers a part of Colonel Bell's Regiment. These units in the active service of The United States Government patrolled the western frontiers of Texas to protect the settlers from attacks by the Indians. See Appendix I for details of Tom Mitchell's service.

After the end of the Mexican War he served as a Texas Ranger in "Big Foot" Wallace's Texas Ranger Company. Their mission was much the same as their wartime mission, protecting Texans from Indian raids.

According his sworn statement Tom came to California in 1852. He mined in various parts of the state for some years finally purchasing his ranch in Soledad Canyon in 1860. His property would be now located near the eastern boundry of Santa Clarita.
